

VCFI Event/Activity Expectations and Code of Conduct

Victory Christian Fellowship International expects all behavior, communication and attire to be appropriate for a Christian environment. We ask that you, as the leader of your group, or parent of your child, ensure that the following standards are upheld and enforced. By signing this form you concurred with and agree to the standards of Christian conduct, communication and attire as defined by VCFI and willfully accept the responsibility for the disciplinary consequences resulting in violation of these standards. All standards and policies and repercussions of their violation (to include dress code) are applicable to all students, leaders, parents, or adults participating in VCFI events/activities.

Standards:

- Involvement in all workshops and meetings is required by all registered participants. Activities and recreation are off limits during these times.
- Honor all VCFI Staff, Leaders, Security, Referees, and other leadership at all times.
- Refrain from all public displays of affection between couples, including hugging, kissing, holding hands, etc.
- Uses of personal electronic devices and materials such as iPods, Cell phones, MP3 players, radios, CD or tape players, magazines, music, and books etc. are prohibited during participation in activities and events.
- Use of inappropriate language such as cursing, vulgar jokes, or explicit talk will result in expulsion of event/activity.

The following violations will result in immediate expulsion from VCFI campus/event/activity:

- Possession of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products.
- Possession of weapons of any kind (guns, knives, etc.) or any object used with the intent to harm another.
- Possession of fireworks or explosives.
- Unauthorized departure from VCFI campus/event/activity location without proper supervision or permission.
- Any sexual activity or possession of sexual products or materials.
- Fighting with another student or misconduct to VCFI authorities.

Dress Code:

- Please read the following dress code policies carefully. Students will be asked to change if they wear inappropriate attire.
- All clothing must be the appropriate length. Short length for girls and guys must be mid-thigh or longer (fingertip length). No Daisy Dukes!
- All shirts/tanks are to have a minimum of a 1" strap and fully cover stomach and back (no spaghetti straps, halter tops, or backless shirts).
- Underwear and bras are to be worn at all times. However, we don't want to see either of them.
- Shirts must be worn at all times, including during sports competitions and to/from pool areas (if applicable).
- All female bathing suits must be modest one-piece suits. T-shirts and/or shorts will be required over immodest one-piece and any two-piece suits worn. All male bathing suits must be a modest length. No bottom cleavage showing, no Speedos, and no street clothes.

- For all services, meetings, workshops, or other non-sporting activities attire should be casual to nice casual.
- No shorts during evening or Sunday service events (Capri's of any length are permissible).
- No hats or ball caps of any kind.
- Nice jeans may be worn (no holes, please).
- Skirts and dresses must be at appropriate lengths, no more than a credit card width above the knee.
- No T-shirts with images or writings of secular or non-Christian content.
